This Sunday is Pentecost and our annual Faith Promise Sunday. Our Outreach Team has selected the theme, "Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples" based on 1 Chronicles 16:24. We welcome Rev. Kurt Selles who is the Director of the CRC's Back to God Ministry International and has been in missions his entire ministry, including many years in Taiwan and China.
