**Student Ministries Update for Outdoor Worship on Sunday, July 19:**

For the time being we continue to not have a nursery or Children's Worship class available but are excitedly planning for your student to join us in worship. Here are some of the ways we are doing that:

- Should you or your student be in need the front lobby doors, under the portico, will be unlocked so you can access the bathroom/changing station located just off the lobby. We ask that you wipe down the changing station with the provided Clorox wipes after use.
- We will have Children's Activity Bags, with coloring pages, worksheets available, and worship guides, available for students when you are greeted at the lower parking lot entrance. This will be yours to take home with you. We do ask that you provide crayons, pencils, markers, etc for use with these bags.
- During worship, we will offer a Children's Meditation. We ask that students remain with their families during this time.
- We recognize that while we are outside, we may experience children laugh, sing, shout or squeal with joy (or frustration) and we celebrate that they are joining us in worship today!

### **From the July 15 Council meeting:**

- The Council is grateful for the financial support of the congregation over the past financial year.
- The Council approved applying our initial investment earnings (\$9,444) to the income for 2019-2020. Our end of the year accounting shows we were \$5,652 short of expenses.
- It was also approved that beginning with this fiscal year and on an annual basis, our General Fund budget will receive 4% from our Vanguard investments as income.
- The 2020-21 General Fund operating budget was approved.
- New Council members were approved: Gary Breuker 1-year term as Admin Deacon: Mary Boven 3-year term as Shepherding Elder: Rachel Pinkston 3-year term as Service Deacon.
- Council Officers for 2020-21 are: Jason DeKuiper – Chair; Tyler Cook – Clerk and Vice-Chair; Gary Breuker – Treasurer.
- A resignation from Council was received from Administrative Deacon Jon Wolffis.
