The Armor of God

¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

¹⁸ And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

In our first Adult discussion time last Sunday we got into two difficult and thorny problems that will obviously require more discussion.

The first was the question of how it is consistent with God's character to instruct people to kill certain other people, particularly in those instances where God ordered all of the people put to death, including women and children. Whole books have been written trying to give a good understanding of these events, which many unbelievers over the centuries have used to discredit God as mean and cruel, and not worthy of our worship. Mike DeWeerd read one of these books years ago and remembers that none of the explanations in that particular book struck him as very satisfying. I went home and read a number of commentaries, and decided I want to dig in deeper, and hopefully develop a sermon on this subject. I expect I'll share what I discover with the discussion group as I continue to study in preparation for this sermon.

The other issue we discussed is the whole issue of homosexuality, and how we need to understand it and respond to it. We decided we will continue to discuss this important subject later.

I don't know what other issues will arise for discussion, but I am grateful to hear what people are thinking about and facing in their daily lives.
