The Prayer Corner

Last week while shopping in Muskegon I came across a decorative plaque with the words **Pray, Wait Trust.** It caught my attention. This is what 2nd Church has to do...Pray, Wait Trust. Did you notice how the word pray came first and then wait and trust? That isn't a mistake. That's the way it has to be for us to clearly see what's dividing our church. We must pray together so that we wait and trust together.

PRAY - When you and I pray we are kept focused on the Lord and on His priorities for 2nd Church. It's very difficult to trust and wait when we haven't prayed first. Remember how Jesus asked His disciples to come away and pray with Him so that they would not fall into temptation? If we don't stay connected to Him through prayer we will be tempted to complain, to be unforgiving, judgmental or hypocritical. We cannot allow Satan to get the upper hand with our thoughts, words and actions. Too much damage has already been done.

WAIT - Yes, that's right. Wait on the Lord! But if we aren't willing, in the waiting process. to truly LOVE each other, forgive, address deep wounds, work hard on restoring broken relationships and building new ones we are like "noisy gongs and clanging cymbals," and we won't get anywhere. Hard words to hear, but so true!

TRUST - What does it really mean to trust the Lord? It might mean that things don't go the way we'd hoped, wanted or expected, and it might take us way out of our comfort zone. But, the Lord has plans for 2nd Church that WILL ONLY be accomplished as we are willing to come together, LOVE each other, forgive and deal with the past under the power of the Holy Spirit. Then and only then will we be empowered to move forward as a united body of believers.
