From Your Student Ministried Director's Desk

Last week I was up in Traverse City camping at the State Park, and I was able to partake in the time-honored Van Wyk Family tradition – people watching. Observing people and seeing what you can learn is extremely interesting. For example, an older man and his wife struggled to park their camper in their spot; there was a lot of yelling and cursing, and eventually, the awning was ripped off before they got it settled. On Friday night, a large group of college guys showed up and began drinking heavily like they were at a frat party. For a few days, we had what looked like a retired couple next to us that didn't seem to speak much to each other but loved to talk to everyone else. If you are like me, you likely started making some assumptions about these people and what their lives might look like with just this little bit of information.

I know I am guilty of assuming what is going on in people's lives and not leaving space for nuance — especially for those different from us. There is probably a reason the older man and his wife were having issues that day; maybe he was tired, their cat had died recently, or their health was declining. There was probably a reason the college guys got together, and each had a specific reason for partying it up the way they did. I bet the retired couple does talk to each other, but I only saw them when they were reading a book. Here is my point: our lives are likely significantly more complex, challenging, and nuanced than anyone around us assumes. So why does that matter to us? As Christians, we know we are called to love our neighbors as ourselves and that the definition of neighbors is broad enough to include everyone. So, how do we love others — people just as challenging, nuanced, and complex as ourselves — in ways that honor God? And most importantly, can we do it better?
