Update from Karin Medical Clinics and Agape Christian School in Gulu, Uganda

Greetings from Joan and Roger Sikkenga to our friends, prayer partners, and donors,

First and foremost, we want to thank all of you for your consistent prayers, encouragement, and support for the Karin medical clinics and the new Agape Christian School. The school has finally reopened after a near two-year hiatus because of Covid.

Deep freshwater boreholes/wells, providing clean water for the clinics and the school, are now in place providing life-sustaining water for the surrounding villages, as well as the clinics and school. The new laboratory is now finished and operational providing, at last, an income stream for the clinics. A new maternity center was opened at the Agonga center now giving us two maternity centers both staffed by midwives. Yes, God has been good, thanks to all of you even during these pandemic times.

God is working with His people, through His people, and saving lives medically, and imparting God's grace and love and knowledge of Scripture through the staff.
