Ukraine Update

We are pleased to announce that we have offered to sponsor a Ukrainian family of four, and they have joyfully accepted. They come to us from Ukraine, the region of Transcarpathian, the city of Mukachevo. Adrian and Maryna Platzer have two children, Danilo who is 8 and Tymofii who is 1.5 years old. They both speak limited English and very much want the boy in school. Adrian works with wood and Maryna has worked in a few different jobs.

They indicated to us the shelling is increasing every day, they have long periods of no electricity or heat and they don't know where or when more missiles will land.

As a group we are excited and anxious to welcome them to Fremont, and help them get settled in. We have started the documentation process which will hopefully be completed by February 1st. After the paperwork is submitted, we wait between 2 weeks and 60 days for approval with a goal of welcoming them by the middle of May.

Please keep Adrian, Maryna and the boys in your prayer's that they will be able to safely leave Ukraine and find peace and joy here in Fremont.
