Mission India Update

A few months ago, you received an email with the video story about a 14 year-old boy who was martyred in the same part of India where the church planters sponsored by Second Christian Reformed Church are working. And then in December, you received some updates to this video story. But here are even MORE updates...

- One believer had hot coals forced into his mouth to prevent him from sharing about Jesus.
 Please pray for those opposing the Gospel that their eyes would be opened to God's incredible love and who Jesus is.
- Local authorities have dropped all charges against the pastor that you saw in the video who was being falsely accused by the village Hindu priest of violent acts. An answer to prayer – Praise the Lord!
- A **second mass baptism** of new believers in the area has just taken place!!!!! God is moving! Although opposition to the Gospel continues, new believers are remaining steadfast, hearts are softening, and lives are being transformed.

Meanwhile, your church planters are continuing to faithfully share the good news. They have passed the halfway point in their training and their progress reports are ready so will be mailed out this week. May you be greatly encouraged to see that several have already responded to the Gospel during these first few months. Thank you for helping to make an eternal impact in India. Keep praying! Ukraine Update

We have submitted form I-134A to the department of homeland security. This is a form that the US Citizenship and Immigration Services needs for us to offer sponsorship to our Ukrainian family. After we receive a letter stating that they accepted the form we then have to wait two weeks to 30 days for approval. Once it is approved then both, we and the beneficiaries will be able to set up a joint USCIS account and share information and wait for final approval. Once we receive final approval, we have 90 days to fly the family to Fremont.

We have been sharing information about the Fremont area and in particular our church, they are so very grateful for what we are doing for them. When the war started, they were living in Kyiv, but the shelling was so bad. They moved back to a smaller city where they were born, near the Hungarian border. Every day they lose their electricity and Internet for about six hours. They have an alarm that sounds when they should head for a bunker for safety.

As Maryna said to us. "This is a big deal, thank you from the whole family. Everything is in the hands of the Lord".

Please keep Adrian, Maryna, Danilo, and Timothy in your prayers.

They are a family of 4 with children who are 8 and 1 ½ years old and are planning to move to Fremont in the middle of May. We are looking for a furnished house to rent for at least 6 months and up to 2 years for their stay here. Prayer Corner

In Ezekiel 37 the Lord sent Ezekiel out to the middle of a valley filled with dry bones. The Lord asked Ezekiel if these bones could live and Ezekiel replied "O Sovereign Lord, you alone know." As Ezekiel prophesied to the bones, there was a noise, a rattling sound and the bones began to come together, bone to bone. Tendons and flesh appeared and skin covered them, but they lacked breath and life. Ezekiel prophesied as the Lord commanded and a miracle occurred...breath entered, and the bones came to life and stood up on their feet—a vast army.

Can you picture such a strange scene? Thousands and thousands of bones coming to life at the command of the Lord through Ezekiel's prophecies. Can you comprehend the power of the Sovereign Lord to raise up these bones and breathe the breath of life into them? Impossible for us...but not impossible for God! In this description of the "valley of dry bones" we read these words in Ezekiel 37:14, "I will put my Spirit in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land.
