Good news! The Form I-134A has been approved and confirmed as sufficient, Praise the LORD! Next up Maryna will create a personal account with USCIS, confirm all their data, vaccinations, etc., and send them on for approval. Once they receive that approval, they will be ready to travel. From THAT moment of approval, they will have 90 days in reserve to leave.

I don't know yet how long it will take to get approval for the next step, but in talking with Maryna, the hardest part is behind us. These words from Luke 22: 14-20...

"When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God. After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. For I tell you I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." And he took bread, gave thanks, and broke it, and gave it to them, saying "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me. In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."

In closing, these words from Erica Wiggenhorn, author of An Unexpected Revival: Experiencing God's Goodness through Disappointment and Doubt (Ezekiel Bible study)

"Taking part in "the breaking of bread" also means being committed to a local church body. We are meant to remember His sacrifice, be taught in the Word, being involved in fellowship—with other believers. And that, my friend, means your local church. It means gathering, worshipping, and serving alongside other kingdom members."
