"Hey family,

I am so very, very excited because this letter will have 2 very big things, one of which I've been teasing about for a month already.

The first is this: Mission Monday is a few weeks away and I cannot wait to get started, but I wanted to take a minute and address something that I've noticed seems to be on many people's minds. Us doing GEMS and CIA as Second Church and not joining the community's shared GEMS or Cadets is not us standing in opposition to those programs. We are not taking sides against them or competing for attendance. There needs to be more programs about Jesus not less for kids to attend. With that idea in mind I have two things: first the reason it's called Mission Monday is that it is a mission-oriented program. What that means is that it isn't geared towards just kids that know Jesus who are already in our churches but is a missional opportunity to engage the community. There are so many families in Fremont alone who don't know Christ and this is how we begin to reach them.
