1 Chronicles 16:8-11, 34

⁸Give praise to the Lord, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done.
⁹ Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts.
¹⁰ Glory in his holy name;
let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice.
¹¹ Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always.

In this passage, we see the nation of Israel celebrating that, even though they waver in their commitment to God, He is faithful. This passage is a wonderful song of praise and thanksgiving because God has once again blessed his people.

What strikes me is how grand this celebration is! We read that David taught Asaph and his associates how to give praise to God. They were to use lyres and harps, cymbals and trumpets! This song of praise builds up to verse 34, where we read: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever."

What can we learn from those words? We, too, are called to give thanks to the Lord our God. And how should we give thanks? Notice how David does it: he celebrates joyfully, singing and dancing before the Lord. David was *all in*. He held nothing back.

I invite you, as we worship, to be **all in!** Hold nothing back! I once had a speaker say to a group of worshipers (in reference to the song "I have the joy...down in my heart): "If you have the joy in your heart, can you let your faces know?" As I lead in worship, it is my prayer that I am **all in**—that my posture reflects the joy of knowing God and experiencing His grace and goodness in my life. As we continue to grow in faith, may God move us to be **all in** as we worship Him together!
